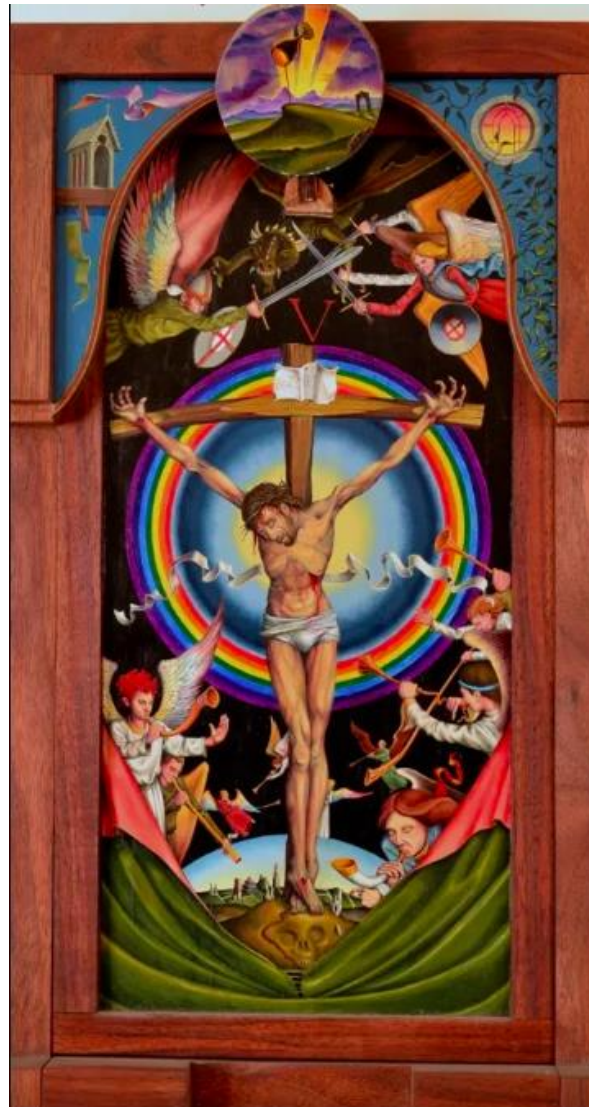

PSALM READING.....Psalm 22:1-15

My God, my God, why have you forsaken me?

Yet you are holy, enthroned on the praises of Israel.
In you our ancestors trusted; they trusted, and you delivered them.
